**News:** In Worship Assembly this week, we discussed the new UK coins. As we enter Carolean era, the coins we use will be changing. Both the 'heads' and 'tails' of circulating coinage will have brand new designs. From the 1p to the £2, eight new coins have been authorised by HM treasury and approved by King Charles III. The brand-new coins feature wildlife designs including the flowers of the four nations, bees, a salmon, a puffin, a capercaillie, oak leaves and acorns, a red squirrel and a dormouse. Together they represent themes of conservation, something that is close to the King's heart. Owl Class pupils have finished their very first term at school! They celebrated with an extra-long Library Session with Mrs Miller – all the children love stories and sharing books, and they have all made super progress with their reading and phonics this term!
