<p>Understanding the World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about the lives of people around us Know some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country. <p>Understand that people who follow Christianity are called Christians.</p> <p>Recognise that there are many different denominations of Christians, but they all believe in Jesus Christ.</p> <p>Learn that Christians believe in one God</p> <p>Understand that Christians believe that if you are a good Christian and follow the teachings of Jesus you are a good person and will go to heaven.</p> <p>Know that Christians worship in a church. Our church is called All Saints Church.</p> <p>Learn that Christians gather to sing special songs about Jesus called hymns (reference to our collective worship hymns in school)</p> <p>Understand that during a church service the vicar or priest gives a special talk – called a sermon. It reminds Christians how to be good, how to behave and how to help others like Jesus.</p> <p>Know children sometimes go to a special school to learn more about Christianity – this is called Sunday school.</p> <p>Learn about Christian special places all around the world for example Bethlehem where Jesus was born and Rome where the Pope lives.</p> <p>Recognise that the Bible is the Christians holy book.</p> <p>Know that the Bible is divided into two sections; the old testament and the new testament.</p> <p>Know that the Bible is full of stories of different peoples lives and stories Jesus told as examples of how Christians should live their lives.</p>		Cross, Candle and Bible	How do Christians learn about God?
