






News: In Worship Assembly this week, we marked National Holocaust Memorial Day by reading the traditional tale of Father Jacob, a woodcarver and Swedish Jew who suffered unkind treatment when he visited Norway to sell the wooden toys he had made – because he was a Jew. Children were reminded about high-profile Jews such as Anne Frank and we looked at Lily Ebert's book "Lily's Promise" as well as "Hana's Suitcase" and "The Diary of Anne Frank". The children were interested to hear that 100 year-old Lily, a Jewish Holocaust survivor, who received an MBE from HM King Charles III last year and has 2million followers on TikTok with her grandson, made it her mission to tell the world about her experiences during WWII. They were also fascinated to learn about Sir Nicholas Winton, who was a British stockbroker and humanitarian who helped to rescue Jewish children during WWII. Children articulated poignant, insightful comments about this sensitive topic and made links to the British Values of Tolerance and Respect, and to our school Bible Quote "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you" (Luke 6:31). In other news, the children who have signed up to the Science Conference at Robert Smyth on Saturday are very excited to be spending the day in the Science Labs at a secondary school and meet lots of other local pupils and their teachers from over a dozen local primary schools. Huge thanks to Mrs Weston and Mrs Guerriero for giving up their day to run workshops for all the children.
