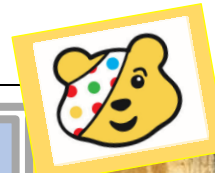

News: The children really enjoyed Crazy Hair and Hats Day on Friday, in aid of Children In Need and we raised over £95. Well done, everyone! In Worship Assembly on Monday, we focused on the story of The Lost Sheep. The children thoroughly enjoyed re-enacting the exploits of the shepherd and talking about how Christians believe that God loves everyone and will help them if they are lost. On Tuesday, we focused on World Toilet Day, a United Nations initiative highlighting how over 3.5 billion people in the world don't have access to safe sanitation. The children considered the impact not having a toilet has on people's lives. The School & Eco Council spoke about Toilet Twinning and their hopes to raise £60 from their stalls at the Bazaar next month to provide the education, materials and funds to enable a community in Malawi to build a safe toilet and eradicate disease and poverty brought about by poor sanitation. The SIAMS Inspector thoroughly enjoyed not only this Worship Assembly, she had a lovely day considering the impact of our Church School on pupils and adults at Clipston.
