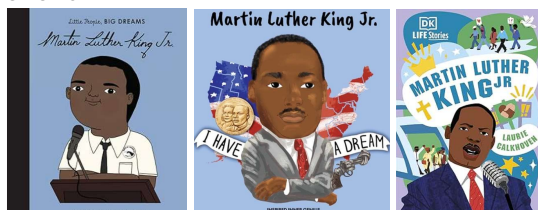

Worship This Week

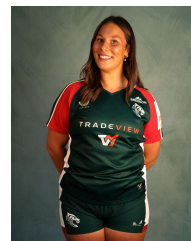

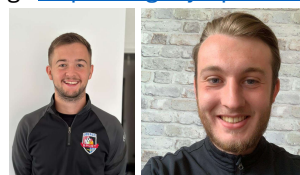
