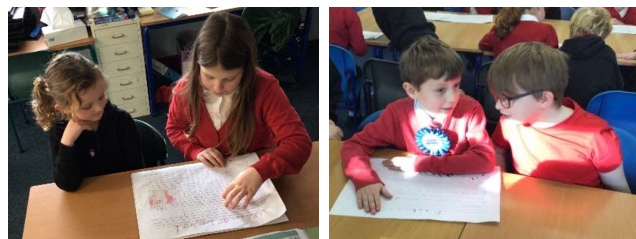
Worship This Week

Our Christian value this term is Love

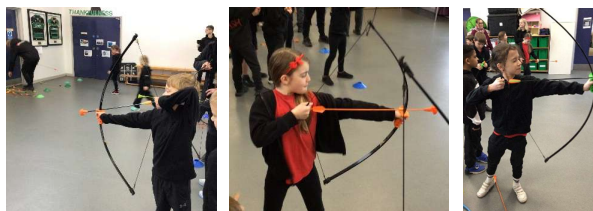
