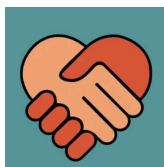

When we keep hold of angry or unhappy feelings, they can grow heavier over time, but choosing to forgive can help us feel lighter, calmer, and ready to move forward.

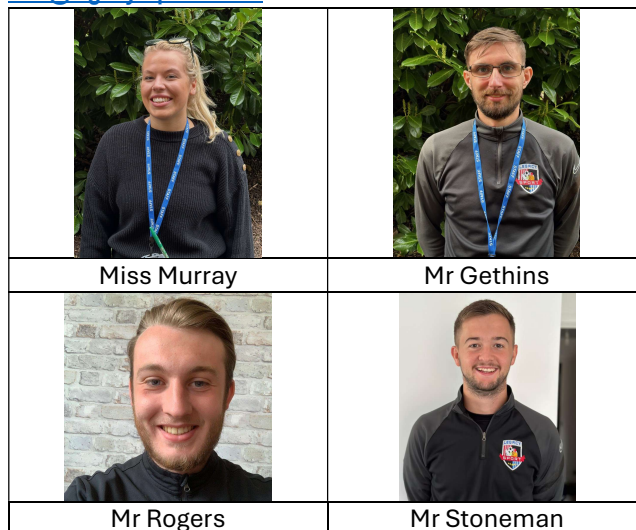
