When a child is fluent at reading, regular practice is **still vitally important** – it helps to develop comprehension skills, fluency and language acquisition. Please can you make reading a priority in your daily routine – bedtimes are often a fantastic time to share a story and a cuddle. If your child is not interested in story books, why not try non-fiction books or magazines/newspapers such as First News and Aquila, National Geographic Little Kids and Storytime.
